



# CASUAL VACANCY

1. Notice is hereby given of a vacancy in the office of Parish Councillor in the Parish of Harlington.
2. Forms of Application may be obtained from the Clerk to the Council, Parish Office, Rear of Parish Hall, Church Road, Harlington or telephone (01525) 875933 or email [clerk@harlington-pc.gov.uk](mailto:clerk@harlington-pc.gov.uk) or downloaded from the website: [www.harlington-pc.gov.uk](http://www.harlington-pc.gov.uk).
3. Completed Application Forms must be returned to the Clerk to the Council at the Parish Office not later than **Thursday 3rd May 2018.**

To qualify for election to a Parish Council, a person, unless disqualified by virtue of the Local Government Act 1972 or any other enactment, must on the day of election be a British subject or citizen of the European Union or Ireland, and attained the age of 18 years and

- (a) on that day is and thereafter continues to be a local government elector for the area of the authority; or
- (b) has during the whole of the twelve months preceding that day occupied, as owner or tenant, any land or other premises in the area; or
- (c) his/her principal or only place of work during that twelve months has been in the area; or
- (d) has during the whole of those twelve months resided in that area; or
- (e) during the whole twelve months has resided in the Parish or within three miles of it.

Disqualification from being elected a member is set out in Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972.
